General Information

Information regarding minimum ages, uniform and other requirements for all examinations are given in the Cecchetti Syllabus Outlines on the ISTD website www.istd.org - <https://www.istd.org/examinations/theatre-dance-syllabus-outlines/> Teachers are advised to check these details carefully prior to entering candidates.

General graded examinations

Candidates should be entered in pairs. Where there are an odd number of candidates, the extra candidate should be entered with a pair, making a group of three.

Vocational graded examinations

Intermediate Foundation & Intermediate should be scheduled at the start of an examining day where possible. Candidates should be entered in pairs except where there is an odd number a group of three may be entered.

Advanced 1 and Advanced 2 candidates are only examined at Centres unless the whole day consists of Vocational Graded Examinations. Candidates should enter in pairs except where there is an odd number, and one candidate must be entered singly. Candidates entering Advanced 1 or 2 in pairs must opt to show the same Option A or B exercises. If they wish to show different options they must be entered singly.

Candidates entering Advanced 1 or 2 **Analysis** examinations must enter singly.

Vocational Graded Exams **All Levels** - those entering the Female Syllabus and those entering the Male Syllabus may not be examined together.

Candidates are examined singly.

▪ Performance awards

Bronze, Silver, Gold, Gold Star Performance Awards.
Candidates should be entered in groups of four or less as follows.
The teacher does not present the work in the examination room.

▪ Class examinations

- Teachers are expected to present the work to the candidates in the examination room for all levels from Pre Primary to Class Exam 6.
- The teacher does not present the work in the examination room at Senior Certificate 1 and 2 levels
- The order of the syllabus should be reasonably adhered to.
- Every candidate must have their number minimum size 8 cm pinned to their dancewear.

▪ Class examination - Pre-Primary

- The minimum number of candidates is two, the maximum is five.
- The timings are as follows:

Candidates	Timings
2 to 4	20 minutes (15 minutes dancing plus 5 minutes writing time)
5	25 minutes (20 minutes dancing plus 5 minutes writing time)

▪ Class examinations - Primary, Standards 1,2 & 3

- The time allowed for each examination is 30 minutes (25 minutes examination plus 5 minutes writing time)
- The minimum number of candidates is one, the maximum is five.
- The ideal number of candidates is four.
- If there are more than four candidates, the group recommendations are as follows:

6	Two groups of 3
7	One group of 4 and one of 3
8	Two groups of 4
9	One group of 4 and one group of 5
10	One group of 4 and two groups of 3
11	Two groups of 4 and one group of 3
12	Three groups of 4

▪ Class examinations - Standards 4, 5 & 6

- The time allowed for each examination is 45 minutes (40 minutes examination plus 5 minutes writing time)
- The minimum number of candidates is one and the maximum is five.
- The ideal number of candidates is four. If there are more than four candidates, the group recommendations are the same as recommended above for the lower-level class examinations.

• Class examinations - Senior Certificates 1 & 2

- The time allowance is 45 minutes for one candidate and 60 minutes for two or three candidates.
- The maximum number of candidates to enter in one set is three.
