

Qualifications and courses explained

Entry Level

Level 4 Diploma in Dance Education (DDE)

The full DDE qualification consists of five individual units and awards 120 Credits at Level 4 on the Regulated Qualification Framework (RQF), preparing students for a rewarding career in dance teaching. It offers a clear pathway to becoming a qualified dance teacher with the ISTD and incorporates the latest research in dance teaching.

Covering Theatre Dance genres such as:

- Cecchetti Classical Ballet
- Classical Greek Dance
- Classical Indian Dance
- Imperial Classical Ballet
- Modern Theatre Dance
- National Dance
- Tap Dance

The programme combines classroom and studio instruction with online activities and assessments.

- Unit 1: Preparing for Safe Teaching Practice (15 credits at Level 3)
- Unit 2: Observing, Assisting and Teaching Practice;
 18+ for teaching practice (30 credits at Level 4)
- Unit 3: Vocational Graded Examination in Dance Intermediate (28 credits at Level 3)
- Unit 4: Dance Practice (30 credits at Level 4)
- Unit 5: Child Development (17 credits at Level 4)

Courses

DDE units 1, 2 and 5 are non-genre specific and can therefore be carried over and combined with the syllabus practical units 3 and 4 to complete the full DDE qualification.



Entry Level

Level 4 Diploma in Teaching Community Dance (DTCD)

The full DTCD qualification awards 52 Credits at Level 4 on the Regulated Qualification Framework (RQF), supporting learners in starting their dance teaching careers. This course equips students with essential skills and knowledge for teaching dance in community settings, aligning with the ISTD's vision of inclusive dance education for all.

At the ISTD Academy, we offer the full qualification as a one-year, online, part-time course. The units are non-genre specific, ensuring a broad and comprehensive education in community dance teaching.

ISTD Academy entry requirements:

- Age 18+
- Dance knowledge and experience, e.g. dance training for a number of years, performing, teaching
- Some experience of being within a teaching environment or a desire to follow a teaching pathway
- GCSE English (or equivalent) at Level 4/C or above (or equivalent)
- Students for whom English is a second language are expected to hold an IELTS at Level 6
- Completed online application form and interview for course suitability
- Enhanced DBS certificate if based in England, or have satisfied any local criminal records checks in international settings

Entry Level

Associate Street Dance

This course prepares teachers to become qualified Street Dance instructors. It is currently the ISTD's only Street Dance teaching qualification and successful candidates gain Full Teaching Membership, with the eligibility to enter students for Dancesport examinations. The Associate is regarded as initial teacher training and is set at Level 4, equivalent in the UK to the first year of a BA Honours degree.

The qualification focuses on three core Street Dance styles: Breaking, Locking, and Popping.

- Duration: 5-8 months
- **Delivery:** Full-day and half-day intensive group sessions combined with one-on-one mentoring

ISTD Academy entry requirements:

- Dance knowledge and experience
- Minimum 18 years of age
- Completed online application form, video submission and interview for course suitability

Advanced Level

Licentiate

The Licentiate is a prestigious qualification, offering a clear pathway, to becoming a higher-level dance teacher with the ISTD while also giving you the eligibility to enter students for vocational graded examinations.

At the ISTD Academy, we offer the Licentiate remotely, tailored to individuals seeking flexible study options with global accessibility. These short courses are perfect for those wanting to become higher-level professional dance teachers.

Immerse yourself in higher-level dance concepts, advanced teaching methods, and strategies to refine your understanding and communication skills.

ISTD Academy entry requirements:

- Advanced 1 certificate in chosen genre or successful APEL application
- In depth knowledge of the current syllabus up to and including Advanced 1
- Associate Diploma or Diploma in Dance Education (DDE) or the Diploma in Dance Pedagogy (DDP) qualification in chosen genre
- Enhanced DBS Certificate if based in England, or have satisfied any local criminal records checks in international settings
- Copies of most recent syllabus books and music from the digital download
- Experience of teaching at vocational level
- Completed online application form, video submission and interview for course suitability

You'll expand your analytical abilities, enhance your effectiveness as a teacher, and develop greater creativity and musicality. Gain invaluable insights and practical knowledge, building a teaching toolkit that sets you apart as an advanced practitioner.

- Duration: 5-8 months
- **Delivery:** Full or half-day intensive group sessions combined with one-on-one mentoring

Advanced Level

Level 6 Diploma in Dance Pedagogy (DDP)

The full DDP qualification awards 120 Credits at Level 6 on the Regulated Qualification Framework (RQF), building on teachers previous training, knowledge, and experience. The curriculum places emphasis on the various ways that dance can be delivered, underpinned by theory and critical analysis, so that students graduate as confident, versatile, and highly proficient dance teachers.

- Unit 1: Planning and Evaluating Programmes of Learning
- Unit 2: The Practice of Dance Teaching and Learning
- Unit 3: Reflective Practice
- Unit 4: Teaching in Education and Community Settings or Licentiate
- Unit 5: Social, Emotional and Cognitive Development

Units 1, 2, and 3 cover essential knowledge and skills for developing dance teaching practices and businesses, including: policy and procedures, professional practice, learning theories, assessment, communication, and reflective practice. These core units focus on planning, delivering, and evaluating inclusive and motivational teaching tailored to each learner. Units 4 and 5 delve into specialised areas of dance teaching, ensuring graduates have a comprehensive and in-depth understanding of the field.

- Duration: 2 years
- Delivery: Online live lectures, group tutorials, and one-to-one mentoring
- Cost: £6140*

Our next intake will begin in September 2027.

ISTD Academy entry requirements:

- Level 4 DDE or equivalent teaching qualification and / or extensive performing and teaching experience
- GCSE English (or equivalent) at grade 4/C or above
- Students for whom English is a second language are expected to hold an IELTS at Level 6
- Enhanced DBS Certificate if based in England, or have satisfied any local criminal records checks in international settings
- Teaching placement to deliver 100 teaching hours
- Completed online application form and interview for course suitability

If you do not meet the entry requirements for the DDP, you can apply for your experience and other qualifications to be recognised through the ISTD APEL process or gain automatic exemptions for certain units via the APL process.
