What are Performance Awards?

Performance Awards are **non-technical examinations** focused entirely on performance skills. They are designed to:

- Encourage creativity and self-expression
- Build confidence and stage presence
- Develop audience awareness and musicality
- Celebrate individual artistry across all dance styles

They are suitable for **any genre**, including ISTD and non-ISTD styles and fusions.

Why should teachers enter students?

1. Inclusive and accessible

No prior qualifications are needed. Open to dancers aged **5+**, with no upper age limit.

2. Flexible and creative

Teachers can choreograph freely, explore new styles, and tailor dances to suit individual learners.

3. Supports progression

With six progressive stages, students can build performance skills over time, from foundational confidence to more refined artistry.

4. Encourages retention and motivation

Students receive **certificates**, **badges**, **and examiner feedback**, helping them feel recognised and inspired to continue dancing.

- Categories: Solo, Duet, Trio, Group
- Assessment: Based on 10 performance criteria
- Result classifications: Pass, Merit, Distinction
- Booking platform: Quest (ISTD members only)

- Exploring new genres or creative choreography
- Mixed-ability groups and inclusive dance settings
- Building confidence in less experienced dancers
