Residential delegates

Delegates staying residentially will be housed in the Chichester University student accommodation on campus. You will be allocated an ensuite room with access to a communal kitchen area. Please note that as this is student accommodation, amenities will be basic, and delegates are advised to keep this in mind. Residential rates include accommodation and an evening meal the night before

the course, breakfast, lunch, tea and coffee breaks, parking and course costs. Regrettably we cannot host delegates who wish to stay in accommodation beyond the end of their chosen course programme. Residential places are limited, so may sell out in advance of the event.

Day delegates

Teachers also have the option to attend this event as a day delegate. Day rates include lunch, tea and coffee breaks, parking and course costs.

If delegates book by 7 April 2025, early bird discounts will be applied. After this period, prices will revert to standard pricing. The early bird discount is only available to members and provisional members, as a membership benefit.

Delegates will also have the option of payment via instalment plan. This payment option is available until 1 May 2025. After this period, attendees will need to pay the booking in full. All payments must be received by 4 July 2025. Please refer to the website for more information.





Mix and match courses: On Friday 15 and Saturday 16 August, you will have the opportunity to mix and match your course choices. Please note, delegates are still required to book and attend a full day's training (6 hours). So, you will have to pick an AM and PM course, across the genre options.

Course times: All courses will take place 9:45–17:30 British Summer Time (BST). Courses will include time for breaks. However, the exact timing of this break may vary from course to course.

Lecturers: Course lecturers will be updated shortly on the website. In the instance of a change to availability, we may need to find an alternative lecturer (than the one originally scheduled) to lead a course. This will not affect the content covered in the course.
